This includes plumbing, electrical, HVAC systems, insulation, and inspections.

INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR FINISHES (4-6 WEEKS)

Drywall goes up, cabinetry is installed, flooring is laid, and final touches begin.

FINAL WALKTHROUGH AND MOVE-IN (1-2 WEEKS)

We go through your home together, address any touch-ups, and hand you the keys.

- Permitting or zoning issues
- Supply chain interruptions
- Weather conditions
- Late decisions or change orders

Communication and planning.
